

dipping step by step

Dipping is an excellent alternative to the usual different artificial nail systems. This system is not based on the reaction of a monomer (acrylic liquid) and a polymer (acrylic powder), as on the case of the traditional acrylic but it is based on the reaction of a polymer and an activator that in this case is a glue, avoiding therefore the application of primer. With this technique, we also eliminated the laborious work of sculpting the nail extension with a brush, the use of files and drill.

Dipping acrylic powder is an extremely fine texture powder that makes level by itself on top of the nail and allows reducing considerably the time of filing. This polymer reacts directly and in few seconds with the catalyst activator.

We can realise this nail service in nails with tip extension or in natural nails, but not with mould. We will recommend this system for fragile and weak nails that break easily with the purpose of reinforcing them.



1- The first thing to do is to pulverize the sany-Spray Lotion over our customer hands and ours to disinfect the area we are going to work on and also all the tools that we will use during the service although it is important that we previously have these items sterilized.

2- Apply the cuticle remover on the cuticles and leave a few minutes. Meanwhile file the free edge of the natural nail so that they are all equals and they fit with the tip that we are going to use.



3- Push the cuticles with the Metallic Bowman Stick n°11. According to the state of the cuticles to work with and if the cuticles are fine and weak, use a plastic pusher or a Birchwood stick.

4- Dehydrate the natural nail first passing the white block and finish the nail preparation applying the nail oil remover lotion over the nail surface.





5-Select the plastic tips according to each nail (the nail tip has to cover the nail from side to side).

6- Glue the tip aligning the demarcation with the free extremity of the nail, in an angle of 45° to avoid the air bubbles. Press the tip a few seconds and also the laterals so that they won't get up.



7- Cut the tips and give the shape of the free edge. In order to facilitate the tip integration with the natural nail, apply Vitrocal Tip Blender on the part of tip adhered to the natural nail.

8- Let it act a few seconds and next integrate the tip in the natural nail with the white block or with a fine file, until the demarcation disappear.



9- Next, apply a very fine and uniform layer of Dipping Glue on all the surface of the nail avoiding the cuticles area.

10- Introduce the finger realising a handle movement, in the dappen dish filled with pink or clear Dipping powder. Realise this movement 3 times and let dry during 1 minute so that the powder adheres well.





11- Eliminate the powder excess with the Dipping Brush and file with the white or pink block to smooth the surface before repeating the previous steps of gluing and powdering two or three times minimum.

12- Repeat these steps the times that we think necessary according to the case. While more powder application, more heavier will be the Dipping nail.



13- File to unify the thickness and polish with the pink or white sanding block. Once the nail is well polished, apply the cuticle oil and massage for a better penetration.



14- Finalise the service with the 3 side Polishing file or for extra shine use the Super Shine File.
